**JOB REQUIREMENTS**

- High School Diploma and/or GED
- Valid Ohio Driver's License
- General computer knowledge
- An Ohio EPA Class I Operator Wastewater Collection System license must be obtained within two years of eligibility to test
- A valid Class B Ohio Commercial Driver's license with tanker endorsement must be obtained within six months of hire date
- Applicant must be in good physical condition, able to repeatedly lift a minimum of 50 lbs, bend, stoop, sit, stand and be able to perform routine manual labor in a timely manner in all weather conditions
- Must be able to climb ladders and work in small spaces such as manholes, pits, and lift stations
- Have the ability to perform oral and written instructions
- A strong mechanical, electrical or construction background
- Must have good communication skills and maintain a professional image when dealing with citizens
- Due to the health and welfare of the citizens of our city, overtime will be required for any sewer calls, sewer plugs, cave-ins, manhole repairs, lift station failure, or any emergency that arises at the Wastewater Plant or Collection System

**BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION**

**Duties include but are not limited to:**

- Acquiring skills to be proficient in the inspection, operations, maintenance and repair of sanitary sewer collection system, lift stations and Wastewater Plant
- Maintain and operate all vehicles lawn equipment, sewer rodder machine, pumps and various other equipment
- Assist maintenance, operators, and jet operator as required
- Operate lugger and tanker truck
- Operate tractor, mark tap locations, use personal safety equipment
- Investigate sewer calls and cave-ins, reset street manhole castings, confined space entry, snow removal, building and yard maintenance, painting and cleaning
- Perform any and all additional duties assigned by the Superintendent or his designee
